Student Assaulted With Paintball Gun

On Feb. 8, 2006, at about 10:40 PM, UCSB Police responded to the report of a subject who had been struck by a paintball while walking on Channel Islands Road. The 20 year old female UCSB student was walking from the University Center on Channel Islands Road towards Parking Lot # 5 (adjacent to the De La Guerra Dining Commons) when she was struck in the head by a paintball.

The student observed an older, tan, four door sedan that was believed to be responsible, driving away from her south on Channel Islands Road. The student received a minor injury to her head where struck by the paintball. No medical treatment was requested at that time.

At this time the UCSB Police Department is continuing to investigate this assault and attempting to locate the person or persons responsible. Even though there is the possibility that this incident was considered a prank by the persons responsible, paintball guns and similar devices can cause serious injury to persons struck by them, especially when not wearing protective equipment. This is being investigated as a felony assault and the persons responsible could face fines and up to 4 years in prison.
